We are not able to guarantee a staff member can be there before the gates open so we would appreciate your support with this.

Over by EYFS and the main entrance, we have 3 queues! We'd like to request that the Reception parents queue on the path to the left of the gate and Nursery parents to the right, along the wall of the building. Year 1 parents can then wait along the fence around the Children's Centre garden. This will keep the lines clear of each other, allow families to leave the site easily and keep the access to the main office clear for other visitors.

Individual awards this week have included those for children who have shown incredible leadership, for kindness, for growing confidence and being positive role models with the hard work and enthusiastic attitudes.


