<u>Curriculum</u> This term, our key questions are: <u>How is the physical world shaped?</u> <u>Beyond the Magic Kingdom: What is the Sunshine State</u> <u>really like?</u>

This term our questions will bring together many aspects of the curriculum. We will be continuing our learning about the Magic Kingdom and explaining the function and attraction of theme parks around the world. We will be focusing on the Magic Kingdom and describe, explain and begin to draw conclusions about the geographical pattern of the origin of visitors from countries around the world. In Science, we will be learning about electricity, different types of circuits, conductors and insulators.

This term our class text is *Wizards of Once* by Cressida Cowell. This is a story about a young boy Wizard and a young girl Warrior who have been taught since birth to hate each other like poison; and the thrilling tale of what happens when their two worlds collide. We will continue to use our Whole Class Reading sessions to explore and analyse the text in detail.
