Curriculum

This term, our key questions is:

Who were the Anglo-Saxons and how do we know what was important to them?

This term our questions will bring together many aspects of the curriculum. We will be learning about why the Romans left Britain, who the Anglo-Saxons were and why they didn't choose to live in the towns the Romans left behind and how their lives changed after Ethelbert met Augustine. In Science, we will be learning about states of matter. We will be comparing and grouping materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases. We will be observing how some materials change state when heated or cooled through practical experiments. We will also learn about the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle.

This term our class text is *The Whale* by Ethan and Vita Murrow. This is a picture book about story of two people who go on an adventure to find out if there really was a giant whale or was it a giant hoax? We will use this text to support our writing in our English lessons. We will continue to use our Whole Class Reading sessions to explore and analyse a range of non-fiction texts in detail.
