Scholastic Book Fair Wednesday 13th, Thursday 14th, Monday 18th and Tuesday 19th March 2024

We will be holding a book fair after school each day in the office lobby from Wednesday 13th March – Tuesday 19th March 2024 (excluding Friday 15th March). The school can get up to 60% of the money made at the book fair to spend on books for our school library and classrooms.

Please enter through the office lobby doors from 3:25 onwards.

There will be a range of books suitable for 3 years old to 11 years old, so please come along on any afternoon to see all of the fantastic books on offer. The children will also have the opportunity to look through the books during class time to make their decisions and write their wish lists. The children can save their world book day vouchers to spend at the book fair if they wish.

To celebrate this event, we will be holding a recommended reads poster competition as part of our World Book Day celebrations. Children are invited to create a poster in school on World Book Day and/or at home by Friday 8th March 2024. The 5 winners will be chosen by the school council and announced in assembly on Friday 8th March. They will each receive a £5 gift voucher to spend at the book fair and their creations will be laminated and displayed in our new look library after the Easter break.

If you do this, the school will still earn rewards on the full value of the voucher to spend on books for the library/classrooms. Just bring the gift vouchers along to the book fair and we can accept them as payment.
